Pros:

- Very sleek quality looking head unit. <u>This unit</u> fits perfectly into my 2010 Corolla and now it looks more modern. I can't describe how happy I am.
- Radio functionality is great. Plenty of preset slots for all of your favorite radio stations, and it will tell you the name of the song and who's singing it. Besides, the radio automatically shuts off when the phone rings.
- I purchased a backup camera to use with this and the screen shows a nice clear video feed. It was also very easy to install, and auto switched when I shift the car into reverse (you need to connect the reverse wire for this to work).
- Bluetooth audio quality is good and CD player is perfect!
- You can change the boot logo from "DVD" to your car's manufacturer.

- GPS load time is about 15-20 seconds, which seems like a long time when comparing to a factory GPS.
- Sometimes callers have trouble hearing me over Bluetooth when they call.

Overall, I'm quite happy with my purchase. Both of the cons listed are very minor and do not change my overall opinion of this head unit. I'd recommend it to anyone looking for an economical upgrade to their Toyota Corolla. Nice work, <u>Pumpkin</u> !
