

How to Install an Android Car Stereo

First, turn off the electricity to the machine by removing the live battery wire from its station. After disconnecting the battery, you'll need to take off the trim boards enveloping your [car stereo](#). Each car just a tiny bit unique here.

Next, you need to dispatch the previous head unit directly out until the wires connected to the back are accessible. Unplug the cord, discharge the cabling harness and proceed to remove the antenna cable by unscrewing it. The cabling harness is the structural fastener that integrates all of the cabling for the sound system into an individual connection. The new [head unit](#) you have purchased should have included an adapter that matched the factory installed cabling. The end of the cabling on the end, should have four to eight colored wires coming from the back. There should be two such wires that plug to each speaker; one positive one negative. Most negatives are shown with a black stripe while positives are generally either solids or have a white stripe.

If your new [car DVD player](#) does not come with an adapter that works with the harness in the dash, you need to purchase a cabling harness kit. The new harness will have to be plugged into the new stereo. Match the colored wire to its match and put them together. After having the wires connected to their proper match, the stereo should be ready to install. Hold the system to the dash to plug the proper connections into the back. You can pause and test what you have done to make sure you have correctly paired the wires.

Once you find that everything is in order; proceed to carefully push the unit all the way into the dash and replace the screws. After the stereo is mounted correctly, put the trim boards back up and reattach everything holding them in place.

Finally, you got a new [Android stereo](#) for your car.

Q14 : Wiring: where to hook up the loose wires on the bundle: 2 browns (keys), 1 orange (illum), 1 orange with stripe (brake), 1 pink (reverse)?

A : This Depends on your [cars radio](#) harness. If these aren't present, you'll need to extend the wires and tap into wherever they are on your car. Keys are for the resistive steering wheel controls. Illumination and reverse are self explanatory, and available in the harnesses under the dash. Brake (and often reverse) you sometimes have to route over to the handbrake area which may require a pretty long wire extension. Get a manual for your car or hire a professional if you are uncomfortable.

Q15 : Does this car stereo come with Android 4.2 or 4.4? If it has 4.2, can we upgrade?

A : Yes, we have Android 4.4; click [here](#) to upgrade.

Q16 : Why is there a TV button on the [head unit](#) if it does not support TV?

A : This unit can support TV, but it needs extra fees to this service in our factory.

Q17 : Hi, the unit works perfectly. However, upon startup the button lights turn on for 3 seconds and then off. How do I get them to turn on and stay on?

A : You should cut the ILL(orange one) cable and then connect

to ACC(red one) cable.

Q18 : Does this unit have aTV? What is the TV button for?

A : Sorry that this radio can not play TV. If you really want, our factory has customized service, but it is a little expensive.

Q19 : Does it have an external microphone jack?

A : This [car head unit](#) has external mic as gift.

Q20 : How long it will take to boot up time from the time car starts till this unit is usable?

A : About 12 -15 seconds.

Q21 : Will this unit be able to use bluetooth OBD2 and bluetooth hands free calling at the same time?

A : You are only able to use bluetooth OBD2 and bluetooth hands free calling separately, not the same time.

Q22: Does it use Google Navigation, a third party navigation or both?

A : we will send you a free map SD card... you can also download a map such as Google, Waze via wifi or hotspot.

Q23 : What's the password for "extra settings" ? Can't find in manual. Already tried 7890, 123456, 1111, 0000.

A : Please try 126.

Q24 : Will this unit work with the axcess aswc-1 steering wheel adapter?

A : Yes,it will. Connect both steering wheel wires from the unit to the brown wire on the harness.

Q25 : Does the unit allow an external mic for handsfree?

A : This [car stereo](#) allows an external mic for handsfree.

Q26 : Does Igo receive traffic if you supply the unit with Internet access (thru 3g or wifi?)

A : You can download Google map via wifi or 3G, then Google map can receive traffic.

Q27 : Is it compatible with JBL system on Toyota Rav4?

A : Sorry, it isn't compatible with JBL system on Toyota Rav4.

Q28 : Which GPS app does this [car DVD Player](#) use?

A : We will send you a beta map card.

Q28 : Is there a way to get this unit to play music randomly? The remote has a RND button but nothing happens when it is pressed.

A : Use a different player. You can use Fusion and it allows random play without any ads, full album art, lyrics and downloads of comparable mp3's. It also has a 10 or 12 band equalizer. To get Fusion to shuffle your entire collection, you have to open it to songs instead of albums or artists and just click the shuffle key once you've picked your beginning song.

Q14 : Why can't I surf the Internet after plugging in my 3G dongle ?

A : It might be the 3G dongle you used is not compatible with our radio. It's possible that you didn't buy the 3G dongle from our store. Would you like to buy a compatible one from [us](#) to try? Also please note that for our 3G dongles to work it can only support a WCDMA 3G bandwidth Internet SIM card.

Q15 : Why does pressing the GPS button to open the Igo maps not work while clicking on the icon does ?

A : Please go to setting-GPS-GPS application option to set the GPS button's function. You can define it to open any map app you installed on the radio.

Q16 : Why can't I open the map or it reports errors when I open it ?

A : It might be the map software preinstalled onto the map SD card is corrupt or lost files. Would you mind we send you a link to download the all map files again to try? Or you can wait for us to send you a new map SD card by post to you? Any idea please let us know, so that we can give you following instructions.

Q17 : Why is [the stereo](#) screen black and no shows no display ?

A : Please use something sharp like a paperclip to press the RST hole on the front panel to check. If it is still not working, please check if the touchscreen and all other functions still work. Does it have sound coming out? If it is only the display is black and not working, then it maybe the display screen or the display board doesn't have power to the backlight of the screen, it may require opening the front panel to check screen board, can you try that? If all of the other functions do not work either, then it might be the device is not connected with power. Please check the power connector and fuse on the radio to see if they are all still good.

Q18 : Why does the radio interface not have voice while others have ?

A : Please disconnect the power cable to the radio, and wait for an hour, and then connect it back to check. We have had clients solve the problem by doing this, maybe this will solve the problem for you also.
